Lt Col R Glover MBE has taken over as ARL chairperson, we wish him, and all teams support staff the very best for his tenure.

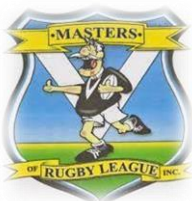
We look forward to welcoming him to our events and support the teams during this year's Inter Services campaign.
